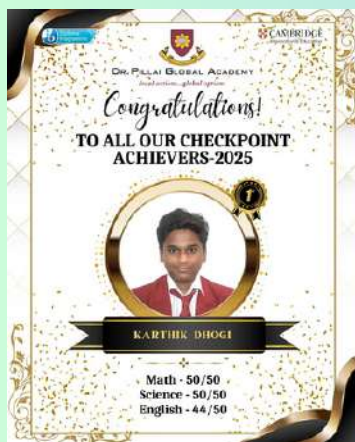

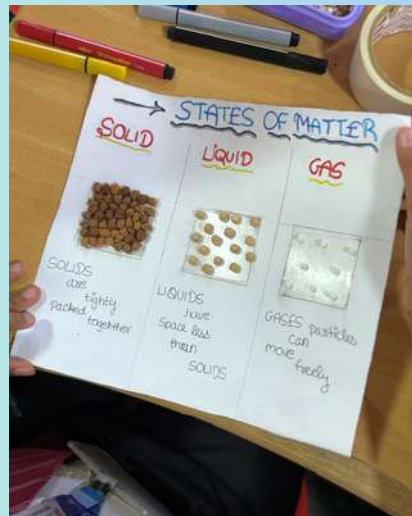
# World Poetry Day

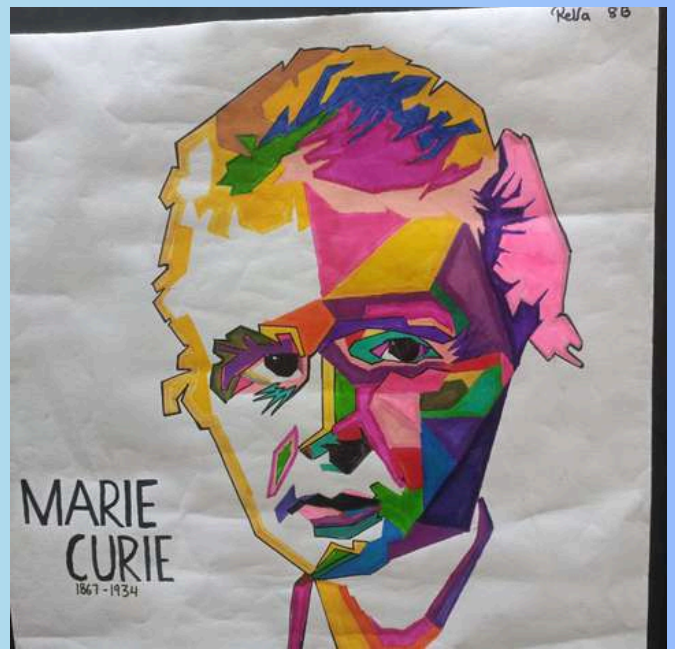
